-- MSI/EMBO Joint Travel Award 2011--

For postgraduate students or post-docs who are members of the MSI, we are offering a joint travel award in conjunction with EMBO to attend and present at this year's EMBO meeting in Vienna (http://www.the-embo-meeting.org/). The MSI will offer one travel grant (of up to 500 euros) for travel to the EMBO meeting, while EMBO will waive the registration fee for the successful applicant.

1. ELIGIBILITY

Criteria for the Award of an MSI/EMBO Joint Travel Award include the following:

- Applicants <u>must</u> be full-time postgraduate students with written evidence of their student status (signed by a supervisor), <u>or</u> be full-time postdoctoral researchers.
- Applicant <u>must</u> be registered members of the Microscopical Society of Ireland (MSI) prior to their application for an award. Membership forms are available on the Society website (http://www.nuigalway.ie/msi).
- Applicants <u>must</u> make a contribution to the EMBO meeting, either as an oral presentation or as a poster presentation. The abstract submitted to the EMBO meeting must also be included on the attached application form for the award. The travel grant offered by MSI will only be made available on acceptance of an abstract to the EMBO meeting.
- Applicants <u>must</u> not have previously been awarded an MSI Student Travel Bursary.
- Applications <u>must</u> be received by the MSI Committee by July 27th 2011.

^{*}Only ONE award will be made available by the MSI. Should more than one applicant have an abstract accepted to the EMBO meeting, the awardee will be decided by the MSI Committee based on the scientific quality of their abstract.
